

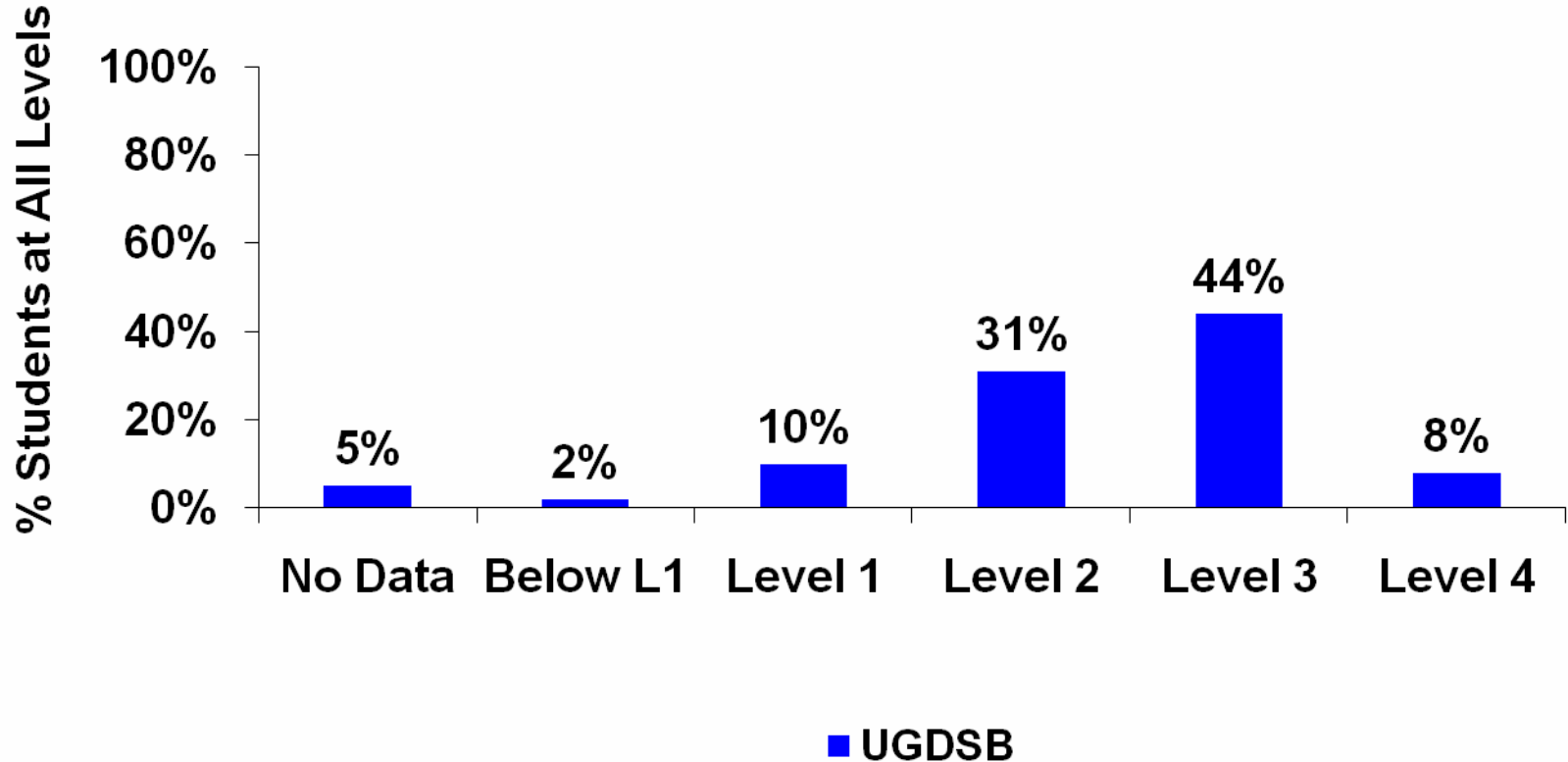
Summary

Students in the applied and academic programs continue to achieve above the provincial averages in the Grade 9 Assessment of Mathematics. The percentage of students at the applied level achieving levels 3 and 4 increased from 47% in 2008 to 52% in 2009. The percentage of students in the academic stream achieving at or above the Provincial standard increased from 77% in 2008 to 83% in 2009.

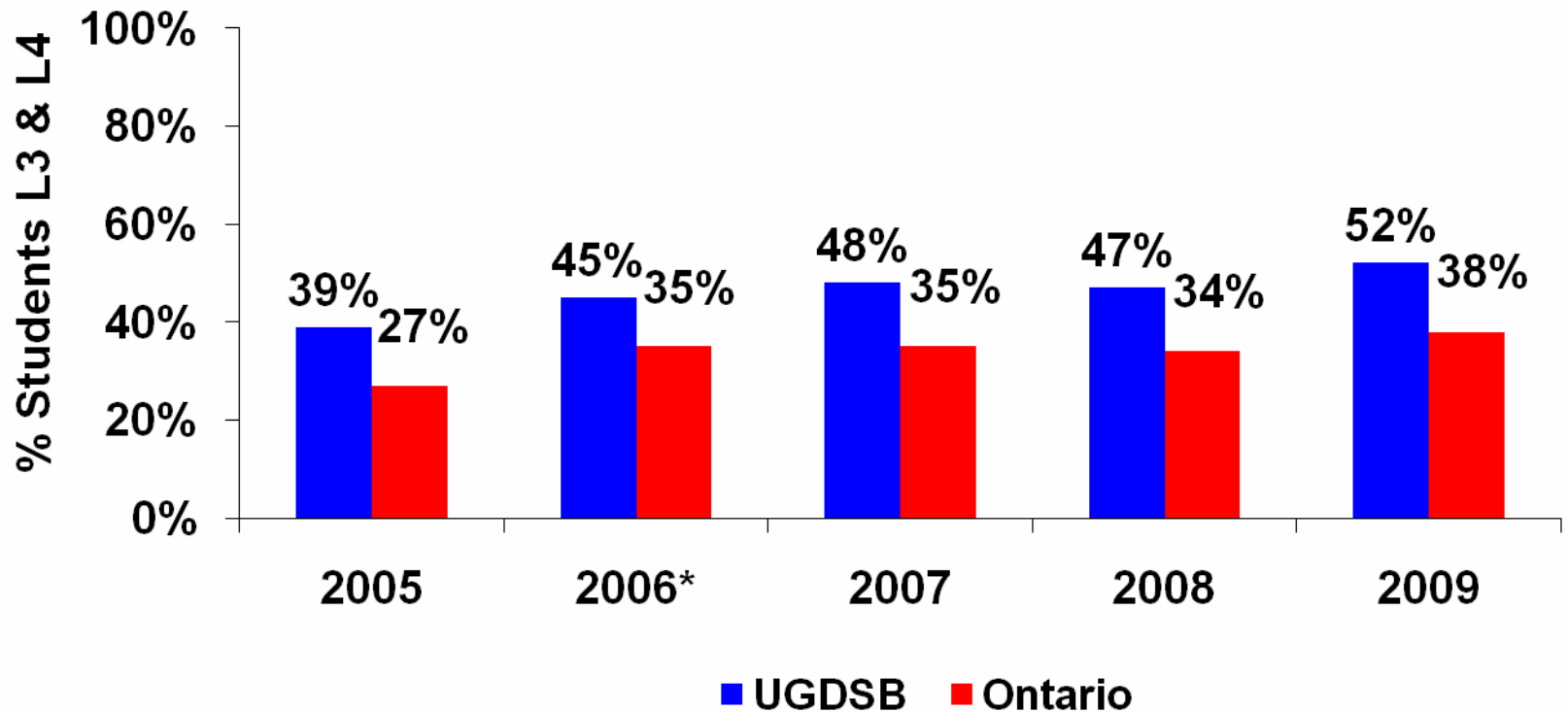
Results by Program of Study – Applied

Percentage of All Students - Applied Program Board Results



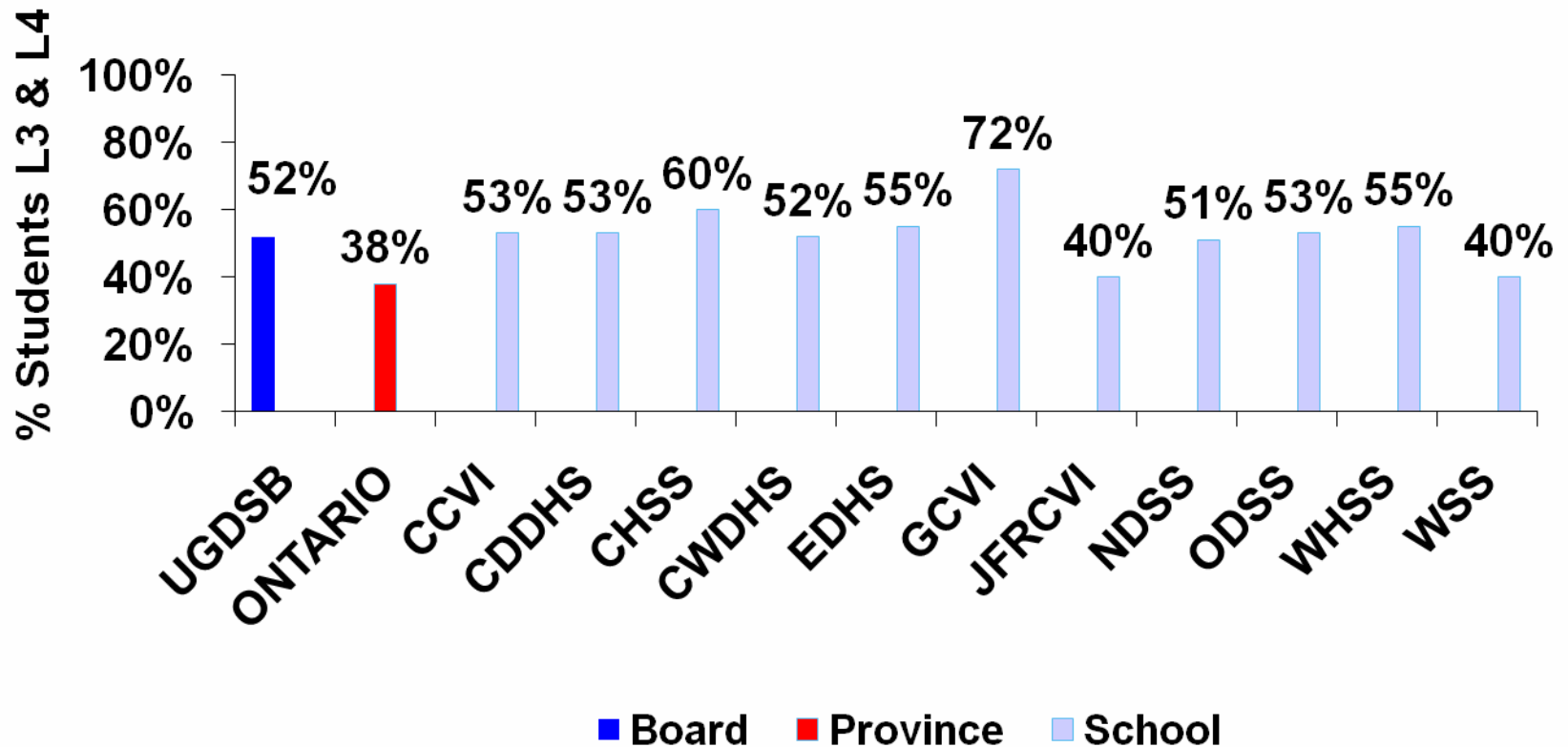
Results Over Time – Applied

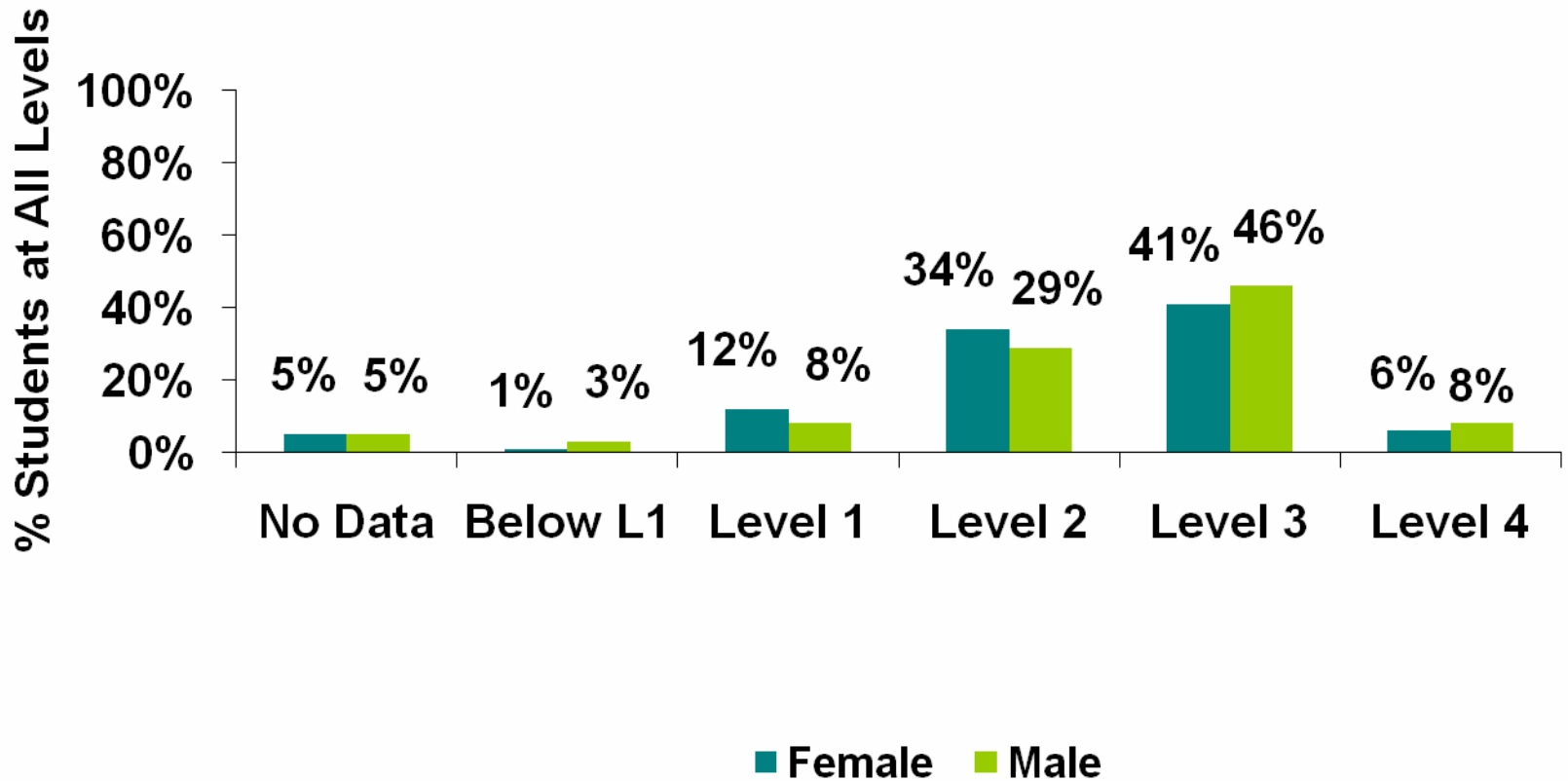
Results by School – Applied

School Results

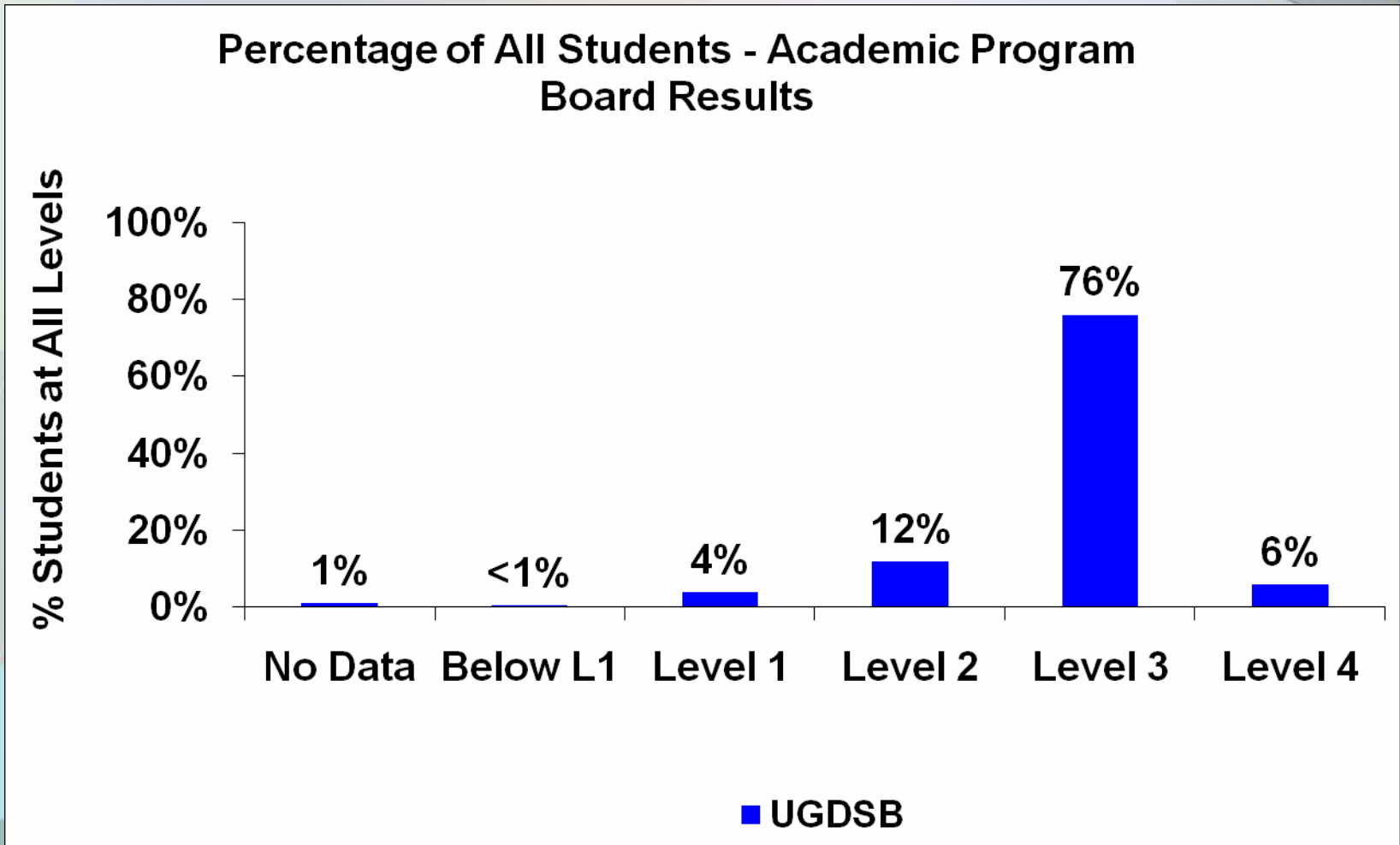


Results by Gender – Applied

Percentage of Students by Gender - Applied Program Board Results

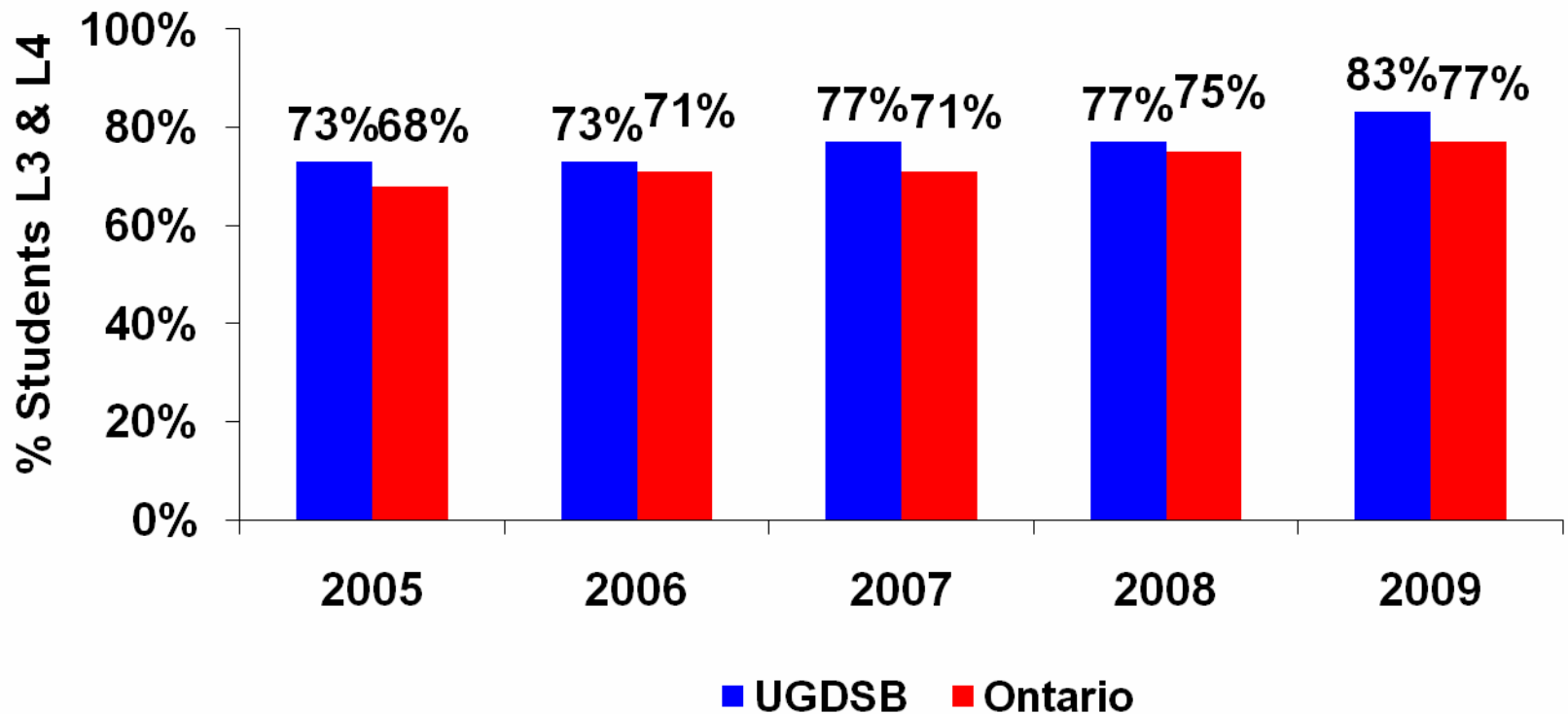

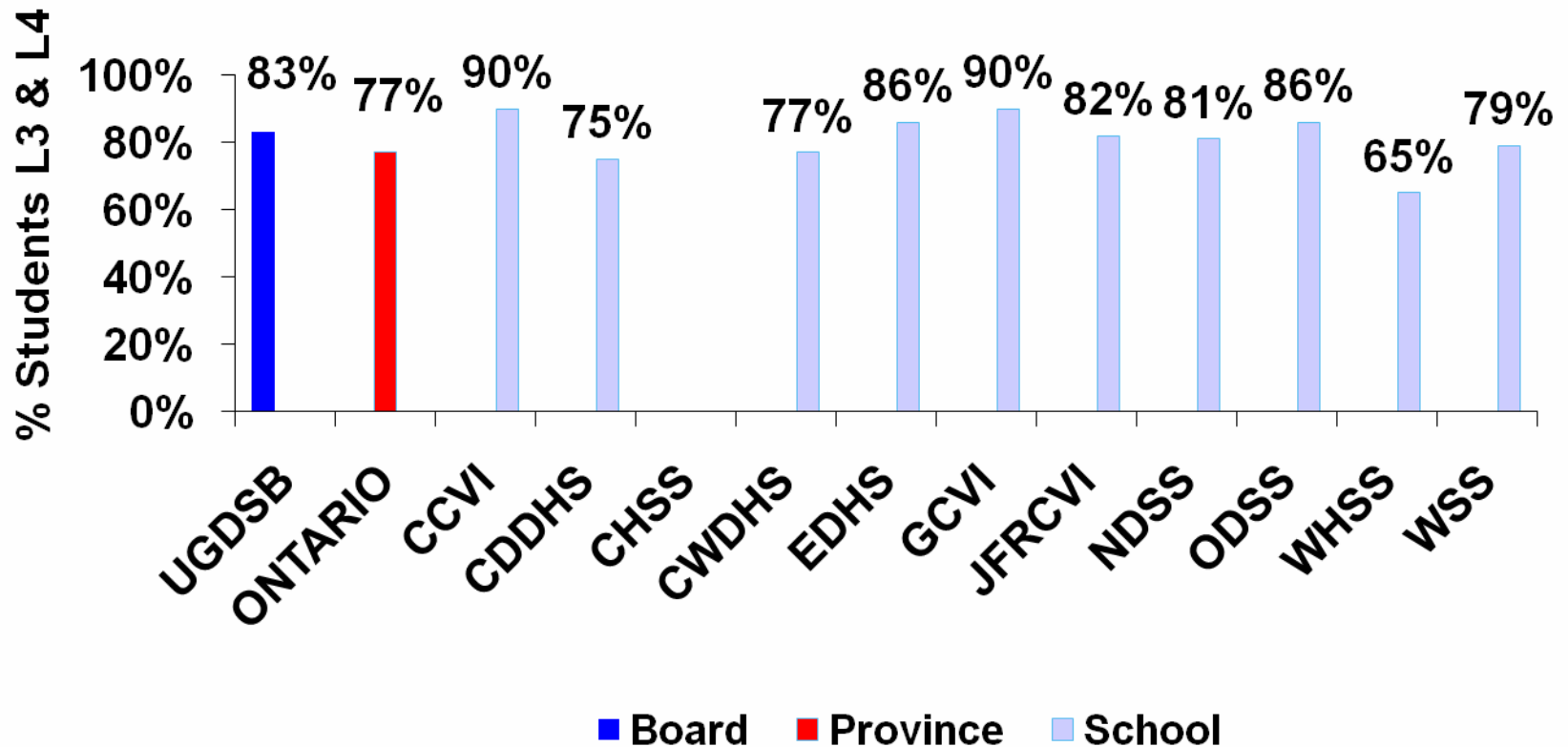
