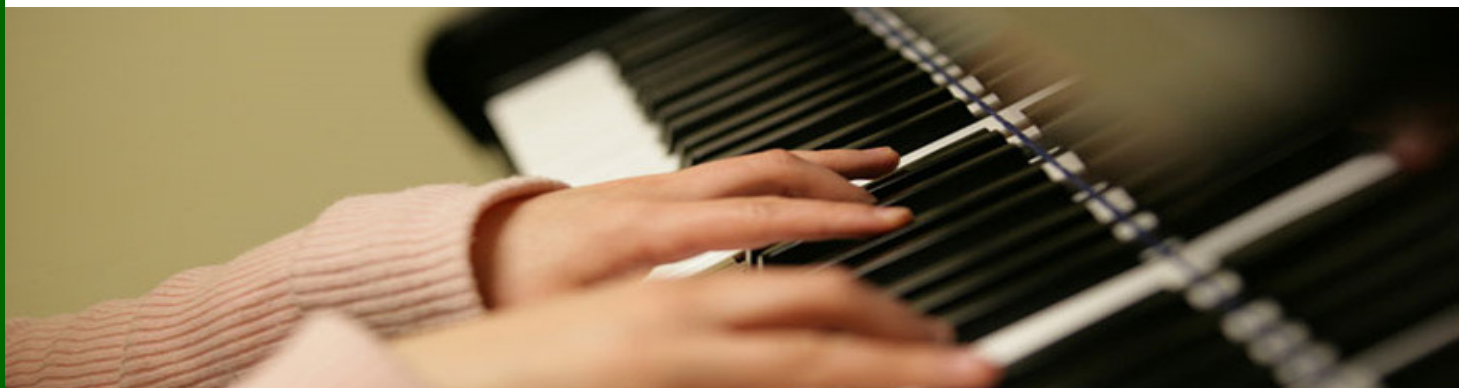

AMI10B

(Beginning) Instrumental Music, Grade 9

This course emphasizes the creation and performance of music at a level consistent with previous experience and is aimed at developing technique, sensitivity, and imagination. Students will develop musical literacy skills by using the creative and critical analysis processes in composition, performance, and a range of reflective and analytical activities. Students will develop an understanding of the conventions and elements of music and of safe practices related to music, and will develop a variety of skills transferable to other areas of their life. Emphasis is on playing a brass or woodwind instrument.

Prerequisite: None

AMI10E

Music - Instrumental, Grade 9, Experienced

This course emphasizes the creation and performance of music at a level consistent with previous experience and is aimed at developing technique, sensitivity, and imagination. Students will develop musical literacy skills by using the creative and critical analysis processes in composition, performance, and a range of reflective and analytical activities. Students will develop an understanding of the conventions and elements of music and of safe practices related to music, and will develop a variety of skills transferable to other areas of their life. Emphasis is on developing more advanced performance skills with a brass or woodwind instrument.

Prerequisite: Previous classroom band experience is highly recommended.

AMV10

Music - Vocal, Grade 9

This course emphasizes the creation and performance of music at a level consistent with previous experience and is aimed at developing technique, sensitivity, and imagination. Students will develop musical literacy skills by using the creative and critical analysis processes in composition, performance, and a range of reflective and analytical activities. Students will develop an understanding of the conventions and elements of music and of safe practices related to music, and will develop a variety of skills transferable to other areas of their life. This beginning level vocal course will emphasize the above by teaching proper vocal production and music reading skills, and by using a wide variety of music representative of many centuries and styles.

Prerequisite: None

AMI2OB**(Beginning) Instrumental music, Grade 10**

This course emphasizes the creation and performance of music at a level consistent with previous experience. Students will develop musical literacy skills by using the creative and critical analysis processes in composition, performance, and a range of reflective and analytical activities. Students will develop their understanding of musical conventions, practices, and terminology and apply the elements of music in a range of activities. They will also explore the function of music in society with reference to self, communities, and cultures. Emphasis is on learning to play a brass or woodwind instrument.

Prerequisite: None (This course is not open to students who have successfully completed Grade 8 instrumental music.)

AMI2OE**Music - Instrumental, Grade 10 Experienced**

This course emphasizes the creation and performance of music at a level consistent with previous experience. Students will develop musical literacy skills by using the creative and critical analysis processes in composition, performance, and a range of reflective and analytical activities. Students will develop their understanding of musical conventions, practices, and terminology and apply the elements of music in a range of activities. They will also explore the function of music in society with reference to self, communities, and cultures. Emphasis is on developing skills on a brass or woodwind instrument.

Recommended Preparation: AMI1OB, AMI1OE or AMI2OB

AMV2O**Music - Vocal, Grade 10**

This course emphasizes the creation and performance of music at a level consistent with previous experience. Students will develop musical literacy skills by using the creative and critical analysis processes in composition, performance, and a range of reflective and analytical activities. Students will develop their understanding of musical conventions, practices, and terminology and apply the elements of music in a range of activities. They will also explore the function of music in society with reference to self, communities, and cultures. Emphasis is on continued development in vocal performance and music reading skills.

Recommended Preparation: AMV1O

AMG3O**Introductory Guitar, Grade 11, Open**

This course develops students' musical literacy through performance and the preparation and presentation of music productions. Students will perform works at a level consistent with previous experience. Independently and collaboratively, students will use current technology and the creative and critical analysis processes to plan, produce, present, and market musical productions. Students will respond to, reflect on, and analyse music from various genres and periods, and they will develop skills transferable to other aspects of their life and their careers.

Prerequisite: None (Students with previous guitar experience who read musical notation should audition for AMG4M to determine appropriate course placement.)

AMI3M**Instrumental Music, Grade 11, University/College Preparation**

This course provides students with opportunities to develop their musical literacy through the creation, appreciation, analysis, and performance of music, including traditional, commercial, and art music. Students will apply the creative process when performing appropriate technical exercises and repertoire and will employ the critical analysis processes when reflecting on, responding to, and analysing live and recorded performances. Students will consider the function of music in society and the impact of music on individuals and communities. They will explore how to apply skills developed in music to their life and careers.

Prerequisite: AMI2O

AMV3M**Vocal Music, Grade 11, University/College Preparation**

This course provides students with opportunities to develop their musical literacy through the creation, appreciation, analysis, and performance of music, including traditional, commercial, and art music. Students will apply the creative process when performing appropriate technical exercises and repertoire and will employ the critical analysis processes when reflecting on, responding to, and analysing live and recorded performances. AMG4E

Advanced Guitar, Grade 12, Workplace Preparation

This course provides students with the fundamental knowledge and skills needed to succeed in the music workplace. Students will, at a level consistent with previous experience, perform appropriate musical works. Independently and collaboratively, students will use current technology and the creative and critical analysis processes to plan, produce, and market music presentations that reflect a broad spectrum of workplace contexts. In addition, students will explore ethical and safe practices related to music.

Prerequisite: AMG3O or by audition

AMI4M

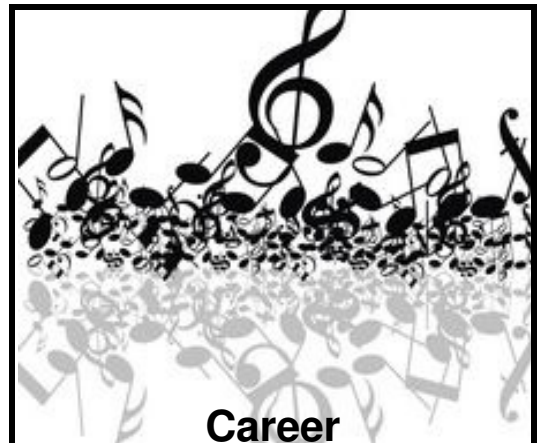
Instrumental Music, Grade 12, University/College Preparation, Advanced
