

POLICY

It is the policy of The Wellington County Board of Education to lease space, where feasible, for non-profit child care.

Administrative Detail

1. It is the responsibility of the appropriate Superintendent to administer this policy in conjunction with the Child Care Liaison Committee.
2. Child care facilities will be leased under the Capital Funding priorities of the Ministry of Education and Training.
3. Child care facilities may be leased by the Board in space deemed available by the Board.
4. The composition of the Child Care Liaison Committee shall be one Superintendent or Designate, one representative from the Secondary Principals/Vice-Principals' Association, and one representative from the Wellington Elementary Administrators' Association.
5. The Child Care Liaison Committee shall:
 - a) oversee the establishment of child care centres that use Board facilities.
 - b) develop criteria for the selection of qualified child care operators for consideration by the Board. "Qualified" shall mean that the child care programs must be operated by incorporated non-profit child care operators.
 - c) establish and implement a process for the selection of child care operators.
 - d) develop a lease/agreement for each child care centre and present the lease/agreement to the Board for its consideration.
 - e) recommend the selected leaseholder(s) to the Board for its consideration.
 - f) establish the duties and responsibilities of Board employees in their relationships with child care operators.
